What is different about Mildred's Lane is that it conscientiously functions entirely to reassemble the connections between *researching, working, making, cooking and living* centered on a new pedagogical model. This unusual program affords participants the ability to collaborate in the production of large-scale research driven art projects within a truly trans disciplinary environment. In addition to the project work, the curriculum is based on experimentally rethinking modes of living.
